





Saastal: Multi-day programmes

Saas Grund, Saas Fee and Saas Almagell are three alpine villages surrounded by majestic 4000m peaks and glaciers. The valley is well suited to learning about one's place in the world, the interaction between glaciers and climate, carbon neutral electricity generation and adventure activities.



PROGRAMME OPTIONS INCLUDE:

Glacier Day: In, on and about glaciers, the relationship between them and climate, and vice versa. Students look at the causes of glacial change and the results of glacial action, especially with respect to greenhouse gas emissions.

Mattmark Dam Day: Experience the immenseness of the Mattmark Dam. Learn about the human and environmental costs, and the environmental advantages of Switzerland's largest earth filled dam and the associated hydroelectric system.

Saastal Myths And Legends: People have populated Saastal since before the Middle Ages even with (or because of?) its fair share of natural challenges and mountain spirits. Children connect with the stories and legends that have evolved through the centuries and will share stories from their own cultures and backgrounds.

Alpine Hut Trekking And Overnights: There are many mountain refuges from which we can choose to link in a single to multi-day mountain itinerary. Students may meal plan and cook for themselves as the experience the 4000m mountains surrounding Saas Fee, The Pearl of the Alps.

Other Activity opportunities include:



Leysin: single day to week long programmes

Leysin is well-known in the international community for its residential boarding schools, colleges, and for its skiing. With convenient access to rock climbing, forest and outdoor classrooms, and trekking routes, Leysin is a terrific location to base outdoor learning experiences.

- Orienteering/mapwork: Students learn the skills of making maps to scale, use of symbols and legends and micro navigation. Campers use compasses, problem-solving and running top off the activity in tests against the clock and each other.
- Earthworks/alpine/forest ecology: The geology and climate of Leysin create a rich diversity of plants and insects. If lucky, students may see deer, foxes, marmots, and other mountain residents. When schools have specific curriculum requirements, we can tailor these sessions to connect to them.
- Living with nature/campcraft: Students learn outdoor living skills, and work together to create shelters, raise tents, start
 fires, filter water, cook on fires and stoves. Knot-work, hygiene, group safety and personal responsibility are important in this
 session too.
- Alpine trekking/mountain navigation: Leysin has a variety of trails leading from the village to lookouts, alpine peaks, and
 mountain huts. The treks can be routed to accommodate a wide range of physical challenge, and be half-day, full-day, or
 multi-day.
- Camping: Sleeping under the stars, the forest canopy or in tents is a part of a childhood that many students might miss out on without school-lead outdoor trips. We supply tents, sleeping mats, guiding and location, the campers supply their energy, enthusiasm, and willingness to adventure.
- Single/multi-day hut trips: As an alternative to camping, schools can choose to include overnights at mountain huts within trekking distance from Leysin.



OTHER PROGRAMME OPTIONS INCLUDE:

• For schools within easy driving distance of Leysin we can provide a taster day as preparation for an overnight programme. This is especially suitable for primary grades when staying away from home for the first time can be a challenge.

- Mountain biking, for grades 7 and over.
- Rappelling
- Rope course (height restriction applies)
- Rafting (height restriction applies)
- Bike touring on bicycle paths in the Rhone Valley.
- Excursions to Saltmines, Montreux, Sion, Aigle and Chillon Castles,
 Broc chocolate factory, Diablerets Glacier, and Lake Geneva.



Swiss Alpine Skiing For Schools

Leysin, Switzerland's Alpine educational hub, offers ideal skiing for all levels. Situated 1260 meters above Lake Geneva and only 1h30 away from Geneva International Airport, it is an convenient international location. Supervised skiing with carefully selected and qualified instructors takes place on weekdays for three to five hours depending on the programme. Leysin is part of the 'Glacier-Alpes Vaudoises' circuit, featuring 60kms of pistes and 16 lifts. Nearby, Gstaad and Les Diablerets provide reliable snow and glacier skiing. Leysin boasts excellent beginner slopes at village level and higher snowfields accessed via the Berneuse Express gondola. Young skiers quickly progress from wide, sweeping runs to confidently tackle challenging black runs.

Exciting Winter Sports: Aside from skiing and snowboarding campers have the opportunity to enjoy unique winter sports in this idyllic Alpine setting. Leysin has its own tobogganing park with tubes for all levels and a full-size ice skating rink. There are also possibilities for sledging and snow-shoe trekking, a challenging but always a very popular activity.





Leadership Training in The Alps

We welcome international speakers to deliver seminar-style talks to the students, enhancing their knowledge with hands-on activities that reinforce the lessons. The primary goal is to foster teamwork and emphasize the critical role leadership plays in shaping group dynamics. Each programme typically features two dynamic speakers per week, aligning with the chosen theme for that specific week. These immersive experiences in the stunning Swiss Alps offer students a unique and transformative educational adventure along with other adventure and educational alpine activities.
